- ▶ **Bachelor of Health Sciences degree** in CLM Traditional, full-time 4-year path & online, part-time model.
- Program designed for students who are interested in being health care administrators.
- Clinical Healthcare Management Undergraduate Certificate
- The intersection of business and healthcare, with an emphasis on providing high quality leadership to healthcare organizations
- Goal: help students become a competent, effective leader working to enact change in health care management
- CLM students develop fundamental knowledge, values, and skills necessary to lead with cultural humility and promote compassionate, efficient, services to improve health care outcomes, patient experiences, and quality of life for every patient
- ▶ **Graduates are positioned** to move into entry-level management positions of health care organizations directing, planning, and coordinating health services in hospitals, clinics, managed care, and nonprofit agencies or to pursue graduate education

- ► I went straight into tech school after I graduated high school and received my CNA/CMA. Would I have to complete my Gen Ed classes to participate in this program?
 - Answer: No, you can enroll without being a degree-seeking student or taking other courses.
- By taking this course would it help me to obtain a job in management preferably Human Resources?
 - Answer: Yes, the Certificate is designed to provide students with employability skills to improve career opportunities in all fields within healthcare administration, including Human Resources
- ▶ I think I'm most interested in how the school/work/home life balance is supported in the program?
 - Answer: Academic and social supports are built into the Program. Designated faculty work directly with students to support the work/home/school life balance.
- Average length to complete program only doing 6 credit hours/semester if you already have a AAS degree?
 - Answer: Full-time (6 hours per semester) students have the ability to complete the Certificate within a few semesters (1 year). To complete the Bachelors of Science degree is longer, taking around 3 years (depending on transfer credit)

 - Answer: Curricular content varies but assignments are designed to build essential employability skills which translate to practical and appliable healthcare administration skill sets. Writing assignments, testing, reading, presentations and professional communication work should be expected.
